KINGDOM OF THE SENSES

Sandomierz - a place where history and the present are magically connected, where Gothic intertwines with the Renaissance style, and where there is a strong tradition of trade amid the traces of the former Duchy of Sandomierz. Once a royal town, today, with its picturesque location and Vistula river architecture, it is one of the most romantic places in Poland.

Anyone interested in history will be fascinated by the errant knight Henry of Sandomierz and the secrets of the Knights Templar. Bearing many traces of these oldest Polish crusaders, the Sandomierz-Opatów region was ruled by Henry of Sandomierz in the mid-12th century. He was the only reigning Polish ruler to go on a crusade to the Holy Land and he also founded a chapter in Wiślica as well as a collegiate church in Opatów.

Time goes more slowly in Sandomierz, so it is worth taking a walk in the Old Town Square, or around its many streets, alleyways and gorges. The view from Opatowska Gate to the Vistula River is breathtaking, while you can get your fill of history and legend with a walk along the Underground Route.

Sandomierz is also the world's striped flint capital, a mineral which has been called the stone of optimism. This flint was

first introduced into jewellery-making by Cezary Łutowicz, an artist who "infects people with optimism" in his studio. The world's only striped flint jewellery collection can be viewed at Sandomierz Castle.

A great idea for anyone who loves the Vistula River is to take a cruise on the Sandomierka, a traditional wooden *dubas* sailing boat. A river trip from the medieval port will allow you to see, for example, the Pepper Mountains (Góry Pieprzowe), one of the oldest mountain ranges in Europe which is over 500 million years old and a big attraction not only for naturalists but also for people who like activity and movement.

For centuries, ancient trading routes, including the legendary Amber Road, ran through the vast Sandomierz region, enabling a wide variety of goods to be transported and kings, priests, artists and merchants to travel along them. In the 16th century, it was written that Sandomierz is an extremely beautiful and charming place. It has many vineyards and is full of orchards producing large quantities of some of the finest fruit around. Casimir the Great and other kings came to Sandomierz to take in the fresh air and relax. The area's natural attributes and the good manners of the local citizens all added to the allure of the region.




In Opatów, which lies on the Amber Road, the old days have left behind many valuable mementoes. A reminder of the "golden age" of Opatów is the Warsaw Gate, a remnant of the city walls that have been preserved to this day.

The most valuable monument in Opatów is the Collegiate Church of St. Martin, an imposing Romanesque building which has a figure of a Knight Templar hidden in a polychrome. Similarly, the nearby church in Ptkanów was founded by the Order of the Knights Templar, evidence of which are the recently discovered labyrinths.

It is not possible to leave Opatów without first trying some Opatów fudge, or the delicious goose dumplings from the nearby Miodowy Młyn. And for dessert, pay a visit to the U Szarego confectionery and try their doughnuts, which have

been baked there using the same traditional methods since 1966. Świętokrzyskie is one of the cleanest regions in Poland, and this undoubtedly has an influence on the unique taste of the locally-produced wine and beer.

There are many religious buildings in Sandomierz and its vicinity, including the Gothic cathedral and the Romanesque post-Cistercian Church of St. Florian in Koprzywnica. During the evening service on Easter Saturday in the Church of Our Lady of the Rosary, a traditional ritual called "Easter Fire" (bziuki) is held, which involves daring local firefighters putting on a display of fire blowing. The Gothic Church of St. John the Baptist in Skotniki also deserves special attention.



HISTORICAL TOURISM

- LIVING HISTORY AND CULTURE

Many interesting cultural events take place in Sandomierz and its vicinity: the Unusual Films Festival, Music in Sandomierz, Wine and Cheese Festival, Jagiellonian Fair, Round the Water Festival, Chivalric Tournament in Garbów, Pepper Mountains Festival (the last Saturday in August), Apple Blossom Festival in Sambork, Young Wine Festival (the third weekend in November), the Jarski Run for Health - Wincenty Kadłubek's Sandals, Chocolate Festival and the Festival of Striped Flint - the Stone of Optimism.

A unique historical reconstruction was prepared by the group Choragiew Rycerstwa Ziemi Sandomierskiej ("Stan-

dard of the Knights of Sandomierz") about the Sandomierz citizen Marina Mniszech, daughter of the Sandomierz voivode, who was the first woman to be crowned Tsarina of Russia.

The trail of the Templars is well worth following and there are tombstones at the Church of St. James in Sandomierz which are believed to be those of crusaders close to Henry of Sandomierz.


The abundance of tourist trails here means it's easy to get to know the Sandomierz region up close, and it is becoming increasingly accessible for fans of active, historical and culinary tourism, particularly enotourism (wine tourism).



RELAXED ACTIVITIES

The Sandomierz Wine Trail and the Sandomierz Apple Trail are two of the most important tourist attractions in the region. The Sandomierz Wine Trail, which begins in a historical vineyard located on the hill where Sandomierz was first located, consists of two sections: the 26-km-long 'royal route' from Sandomierz to Klimontów which covers six vineyards, and the 5.6-km-long 'pepper route' from Sandomierz to Kamień Łukawski in the Pepper Mountains which takes in three. Interesting routes in Sandomierz can also be explored in small electric vehicles (called melexes),

with the whole region being an ideal place for cyclists. For those who like to discover new places which are more off the beaten track, we recommend all-day off-road trips along the gorges and trails of the Vistula. For those who love relaxed activities, we offer walks along the bottom of a prehistoric sea in the Pepper Mountains, as well as bikes, kayaks and traditional wooden sailing boats. Sandomierz and its vicinity is an ideal place for runners and walkers, and it's just made for a romantic weekend.

cuisine and local specialties offered on this Appetizing Trail...



IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF HENRY OF SANDOMIERZ AND THE KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

DAY 1

10.00 Visit to Sandomierz to see the knights, armoury and a short chivalric tournament.

11.00 A look around Sandomierz Castle & Regional Museum - artefacts of Henry of Sandomierz - a denar and lion's head from the Church of St. James.

12.00 Visit to the Church of St. James to see crusaders' tombstones, possibly followers of Henry of Sandomierz. Visit to the St. James vineyard for a tasting of local wines and cheeses.

Searching for the treasures of the Templars

- **12.00** Opatów a city of treasures: Collegiate Church of St. Martin, underground route, Bernardine monastery, the Żmigród area (known as the old castle) and the Warsaw Gate (on foot).

- **15.30** Transport to Ujazd for a visit to Krzyżtopór Castle, a palazzo in fortezza (fortified palace) built during the years 1631-1644 by Krzysztof Ossoliński, with typically Sarmatian flair.
- **17.15** Walk around Klimontów. In 1604, the Sandomierz voivode Jan Zbigniew Ossoliński founded the new town of Klimontów, which is dominated by two religious complexes established by the Ossoliński family.



Leading through Skotniki, Ossolin, Samborzec and Złota, the excursion covers 72 km and takes 4 hours. The programme includes:

- Visit to a vineyard, local wine and cheese tasting.
- The Vege Point stop on the Sandomierz Apple Trail at

Świeże Poddasze u Przybyszów in Andruszkowice, which has an artistic atmosphere. The 'Press the Power' programme is time for a healthy juice made from local Sandomierz fruits with an artistic story.

14.00 Lunch.

15.30 Visit to the underground route in Sandomierz.

17.30 Feast with regional dishes and amusements at the Wojtasówka agrotourism farm / Willa Wojtasówka.



DAY 4

10.00 Excursion towards Opatów.

Route: Sandomierz - Międzygórz - Włostów - Opatów - Iwaniska - Ujazd - Klimontów - Lipnik - Sandomierz (approx. 100 km).

A trip along a trail of old castles and palaces, historic churches, miraculous springs and famous people. The most important points of the trip are: the ruins of a medieval castle in Międzygórze, the spring of Wincenty Kadłubek in Karwów, the remains of the Karski palace in Włostów, the Romanesque Collegiate Church of St. Martin of Tours in Opatów, the ruins of the Sarmatian palace - the Ossoliński fortress in Ujazd and the monuments of Klimontów.


